St Ambrose, Bishop, Doctor 7th December

St. Ambrose, Bishop of Milan lived in the 4th century. Ambrose, a great theologian, is also credited with various hymns and spiritual poems. St Augustine once wrote of Ambrose: "Blessed Ambrose has sung ... beautifully in the hymn ... speaking about the Lord Christ, he speaks as follows: 'His departure from the Father, his return to the Father; his journey down to hell, his journey back to the seat of God.'"
